Conference Dates

The conference begins at 2pm on Wednesday 22nd September – registrations from 1pm – and closes at 5pm on Friday 24th September 2010.

Conference Venue

Clare College founded in 1326 is the second oldest college in Cambridge. Its spectacular 17th Century buildings are matched by modern conference facilities of exceptional quality and high standard accommodation. The reception and conference dinner on the second night will be held in the Great Hall of the college. The plenary sessions will take place in the Riley Auditorium and group sessions in the syndicate rooms in the same building - the Gillespie Centre.



Conference Costs

Meeting conference costs takes a number of forms:

Through a funding arrangement with EUCCONET (<http://euconet.site.ined.fr>) European participants, including up to 10% of non-European participants, may apply to have their conference and travel costs (economy class) met by EUCCONET bursaries.

All presenters will be eligible for bursaries - *one* per paper or poster – and for a limited number of other participants on a first come-first served basis. Applications will be particularly welcome from young researchers. The deadline for bursary applications is **9th July 2010**. You will receive notification of the result of your application by **16th July 2010**.

Participants who are awarded a bursary will be required to attend the whole conference.

Other participants paying their own way are encouraged to attend the whole conference, but for those unable to do so day rates are available. Applications for non-EUCCONET funded attendance at the conference will be accepted from **17th July 2010**.

Conference fee covers:

- **Accommodation**

The funding for the conference will cover the cost of a standard single room with breakfast for all participants who require accommodation in Cambridge. Accommodation will be in the grounds of Clare College, Cambridge, UK.

- **Meals**

Breakfast, lunch and refreshments on Thursday 23rd and Friday 24th September will be provided for participants. A buffet dinner preceded by drinks will be available on the evening of Wednesday 22nd September. There will be a three course conference dinner in the Great Hall, preceded by a reception, on Thursday 23rd September.

- **Travel**

Participants are expected to make their own travel arrangements (economy class). For those awarded EUCCONET bursaries there will be reimbursement subsequently against provision of receipts.

Early booking of travel is recommended to take advantage of the most economical rates. EUCCONET participants are expected to use public transport for transfers from airports and train stations to Clare College, Cambridge.
